Statement delivered by H.E. Ahmed Samir Saleh Minister of Trade and Industry of Egypt at the Sixth Summit of the Conference on Interaction and Confidence Building Measures in Asia (CICA)

Mohamed ElOraby, Former Foreign Minister of Egypt to the Council of Eminent Persons, which we look forward to its launch soon. As well as nominating Al-Ahram Center for Political and Strategic Studies to the CICA Think Tank Forum.

Egypt is looking forward to include our shared commitment to stick to previously agreed upon language, positions and principles, especially with regards to the peace process in the Middle East, as this issue remains at the forefront of Egyptian, Palestinian and many other Arab and Islamic Countries' Foreign Policies.

Egypt also welcomes enhanced cooperation between CICA and the different regional organizations, namely the Arab league and the African Union, among others.

Egypt also welcomes and supports granting the CICA Member State status to Kuwait during this Summit.
